



Woolly spiders



1. You will need two pipe cleaners, black wool, paper, scissors, a felt pen and double sided tape.

Alternatively you can use PVA (and some patience) to stick down the eyes, or make a small loop with sticky-tap.



2. Cut the pipe cleaners in two and tie the four pieces together at the centre.



3. Start wrapping the wool around the centre of the pipe cleaner bundle, keep wrapping until you have made a little ball of wool – or a spider body! Loop the wool back around itself at the 'top' of the spider and tie a knot – leave the end of the wool attached



4. Draw your spider eyes on the paper, cut them out and stick to the spider using double-sided tape or glue.

Bend the pipe cleaners to form joints and feet. Hang your spider up!
